The Tea Cozy Tea Cozy



Materials: Cascade 220 Superwash Paints

#7 needles

Gauge: 5 st/in in Stockinette

Abbreviations: K knit, P purl, SI slip, St(s) stitch(es)

Slip Stitch Pattern: (multiple of 8 + 1)

Row 1: (RS) K2, * Sl1, K1, Sl1, K1, Sl1, K3; repeat from *

Across row to last 7 sts, Sl1, K1, Sl1, K1, Sl1, K2.

Row 2: K2, * PI, K1, P1, K1, P1, K3; repeat from *

Across row to last 7 sts, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K2.

All Slip Stitches should be slipped purlwise with the yarn in back.

I-cord: Row 1: K4, slip these 4 sts back to left needle.

Repeat this row as required.

Dec 2: Insert right needle into 2 sts together, knitwise, to slip to right needle, K1, use left needle tip to pass both slipped

stitches up and over the knitted stitch and off the right needle.

Instructions:

Make 2 pieces alike.

Cast on 57 sts. Knit 5 rows.

Begin Slip Stitch Pattern with Row 2.

Work Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures 5" from beginning (or length to fit your tea pot).

Decrease Row 1 (RS): K2, * Sl1, Dec 2, Sl1, K3; repeat from * to last 7 sts, Sl1, Dec 2, Sl1,

K2. (43 sts)

Row 2: K2, * Pl, K1, Pl, K3; repeat from * to last 5 sts, Pl, K1, Pl, K2.

Row 3: K2, * Sl1, K1, Sl1, K3; repeat from * to last 5 sts, Sl1, K1, Sl1, K2.

Row 4: repeat Row 2

Row 5 & 6: repeat rows 3 & 4

Row 7: K2, * Sl1, K1, Sl1, Dec 2; repeat from * to last 5 sts, Sl1, K1, Sl1, K2. (31 sts)

Row 8: K2, * Pl, K1; repeat from * to last st, K1.

Row 9: K2, * Sl1, K1; repeat from * to last st, K1.

Row 10: repeat Row 8

Row 11: K2, * Dec 2, K1; repeat from * to last 5 sts, Dec 2, K2. (17 sts)

Row 12: repeat row 8.

Row 13: K2 tog, * Sl1, K1; repeat from * to last 3 sts, Sl1, K2 tog. (15 sts)

Row 14: * K1, PI; repeat from * to last st, K1.

Row 15: K1, * Dec 2, repeat from * to last 2 sts, K2 tog. (6 sts)

Row 16: * K1, PI; repeat from *to end.

Row 17: Dec 2 twice. (2 sts)

Put the 2 sts on a holder while making the 2nd piece.

Finishing:

Sew side seams, leaving openings for the handle and spout.

Work I-cord on 4 sts, 2 sts from each piece, until it is 3" long.

Sew the I-cord end to beginning of I-cord, making a loop.
